## FDP/ SEMINARS/WEBINARS/GUEST LECTURES AS PER INSTITUTE'S CALENDAR

### Group Discussion Session, July 4, 2022

To impart knowledge about how to clear group discussion round in college placements, Management Club of Institute organized a group discussion session. He talked about various tools like Google Fact, Check Explorer, Fact Checking, etc. Dr. Diksha Khera, Assistant Professor, IITM presented a comprehensive set of statistical techniques along with specific problem situations where they are applicable. Dr. Ruby Dahiya, Associate Professor, IITM discussed about Agent Based Modeling. Another session on Profession Teaching was taken by Dr. Shikha Rai, Faculty, School of Journalism & New Media Studies, IGNOU. She discussed on the topic "How to be an Influential Teacher". Dr. Deepika Arora, HOD, BBA Department discussed about role of teachers as professionals. This was followed by an interesting talk by Dr. Mandeep Singh, Placement Manager and Associate professor, IITM on Employability skills. He elaborated on significance of employability skills. 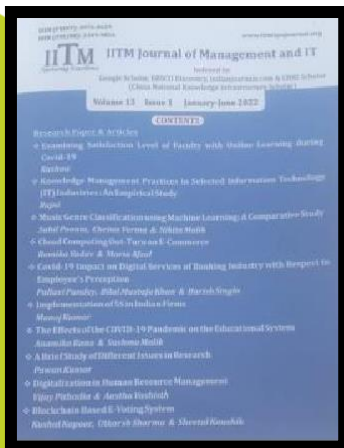
### **Plantation Quest – Treasure Hunt X Plantation Drive, November 29, 2022**
