**Functional Duties & Responsibilities:**

**Coordinator:**

- The coordinator is overall incharge of the committee and is responsible for the performance of the committee in meeting its objectives within the framework of its policy.

**Members:**

- The individual faculty members are responsible for the tasks assigned by the coordinator for the conduction of various events such as displaying notices for the events, conduction of the events, compilation and announcement of the results followed by reporting of the events. The members are also responsible for maintenance of database of students who participate in various events and their performance besides issuance of certificates and trophies for various events.
- The students are allowed complete autonomy in conduction of the events under the supervision of the respective faculty members handling the event.
- To keep a check upon the discipline among the students of different events.

**Students Representatives:**

- The student representatives are responsible for discipline in the teams and supporting the faculty members in their duties during the conduction of the events.
