## SPORTS COMMITTEE- POLICY

### AIM

The Sports Committee at IITM Janakpuri aims to promote a culture of sportsmanship, physical fitness, and holistic development among students and faculty members. The committee endeavors to organize and facilitate various sports events, both intra-college and inter-college, to provide opportunities for students to excel in sports and recreational activities.

### OBJECTIVE

The Institute is dedicated to systematically providing the necessary financial and other support to students, empowering them to achieve their aspirations of excelling in sports competitions and winning medals.

1. **Ensure Universal Access to Sports and Physical Education:**
  - Offer inclusive access to sports and physical education programs for all students, irrespective of background or ability, fostering a culture of health and well-being.
2. **Foster Mass Participation and Sports Culture:**
  - Cultivate a vibrant sports club culture within the Institute, encouraging widespread participation in sports competitions and events.
  - Advocate the benefits of sports to promote youth development and holistic well-being.
3. **Provide Equal Opportunities:**
  - Guarantee equal opportunities for all students to engage in sports activities, regardless of gender, socio-economic status, or physical ability, fostering an environment of inclusivity and fairness.
4. **Promote Excellence in Sports:**
  - Strive for excellence in sports performance, providing opportunities and resources for athletes to hone their skills and achieve their full potential.
5. **Develop and Utilize High-Quality Sports Infrastructure:**
  - Invest in the development, maintenance, and optimal utilization of state-of-the-art sports facilities, ensuring that students have access to top-notch infrastructure to support their athletic pursuits.
6. **Cultivate a Culture of Sports and Ethical Values:**
  - Instill higher moral and ethical values among students through sports, fostering traits such as integrity, teamwork, and perseverance.
  - Encourage a spirit of comradeship and a relentless desire for personal and collective excellence in sportsmanship.



**7. Channelize Youth Energy for Sports and Fitness:**

- Harness the energy and enthusiasm of youth for sports activities and physical fitness, promoting a healthy and active lifestyle among students.

**8. Recognize and Reward Sporting Talent:**

- Identify and acknowledge exceptional talent in sports among both women and men students, celebrating their achievements and providing incentives to inspire further excellence.

By adhering to these objectives, the Institute aims to create an environment conducive to the holistic development of students, nurturing their athletic potential and fostering a lifelong love for sports and physical fitness.

## CONSTITUTION OF COMMITTEE

1. **Selection of Coordinator:** The Sports Coordinator is appointed and designated by the Director.
2. **Selection of Faculty Members:** The faculty members (1 male and 1 female) of the Sports Committee are selected by the Director with the consent of the Sports Coordinator.
3. **Selection of Student Representatives:** Students are encouraged to act as Sports Representatives. They are selected based on their past achievements. At the time of admission in the first year, the sports coordinator scrutinizes the registration forms, where students list their sports achievements.
4. **Number of Members:** Sports Coordinator = 1 & Sports Members = 2 (1 male and 1 female).
5. **Role of Coordinator:** The coordinator is overall responsible for the success of sports events. Their role includes managing sports events at the intra-college, inter-college, and university levels. The broad purpose of the position and its responsibilities are:
  - The sports coordinator is responsible for planning and delivering an engaging, safe, and inclusive sporting program targeting the students.
  - Endeavor to maintain or increase current sports programs and explore opportunities to offer and promote alternative/new programs.
  - Provide opportunities for student leadership in areas such as officiating, coaching, and event management.
  - Provide necessary equipment and uniforms as required. Additionally, arrange necessary administrative approvals, student consent/payment, and venues, including any associated payments.
6. **Role of Faculty Members:** The members of the committee assist the coordinator in overseeing the committee and facilitate the coordinator in the committee's workings.
7. **Role of Student Representatives:** The student representative serves as a point of contact with students representing the college in sports and organizes sporting and recreational activities in college. They interact with other colleges to encourage support and popularize sports activities.



## **RESPONSIBILITY OF COMMITTEE**

Some specific responsibilities of the Sports Committee are as follows:

1. Coordinating with the students.
2. Keeping stock of sports goods from previous and current years.
3. Conducting an annual event at DDA Sports Complex (Hari Nagar or Dwarka).
4. Selecting teams for participation in the IPU Sports meet.
5. Ordering sports goods in consultation with the Chairman and Director.
6. Arranging venues for sports events.
7. Selecting teams for various sports.
8. Coordinating with the Director:
  - i. Obtaining permission to hold indoor sports events on the college campus.
  - ii. Recommending students for permission to participate in intra- or inter-college events / University Annual Sports Meet.
  - iii. Recommending sanction for Entry/Registration Fees to participate in various sports events.
  - iv. Recommending attendance for students who have taken part in sports events.
9. Maintaining discipline in all events inside and outside the college.
10. Compiling reports of sports events attended by students outside the college. This is particularly crucial for the Annual Day, as the information is required for the Director's Report and Prize Distribution Ceremony.
11. Finalizing the schedule of events for the entire academic year well in advance in consultation with the Director.

## **Sports Equipment Utilization by students and Faculty Members**

Various sports equipment and facilities are available at the IITM Campus for use by students and faculty members. Any student or faculty member can utilize these facilities.

The general rules for the issuance and return of these facilities are outlined as follows:

1. Sports equipment can be lent to students upon submission of their ID card. Upon returning the equipment, students will receive their ID card back.
2. If any sports equipment issued is damaged due to misuse or mishandling, the student will be responsible for covering the cost of repair or replacement.
3. Faculty members can obtain equipment issuance with written permission from the Director or Deputy Director.
